- **Elementary Meet & Greet:** Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup> – 10:00 am – 12:00 pm. Class lists will be posted on this day! Come and meet your teacher during this open house time.
- **Dockets:** Dockets will be collected from your student(s) on Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup>. APA purchased your first docket, however, we cannot purchase another one for your student(s). If your dockets are torn or lost, we will have extras that can be purchased through the office. The docket alone is \$8.00 and the inside folders are \$2.00. If you need a complete replacement, the cost is \$10.00.
- **Name Badges:** will be collected from your student(s) on Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup>. Your teachers and instructors are in the process of making sure all students have a name badge. If you receive a note home stating that your student is missing their name badge, please help your student try to find it or send in the \$5.00 for a replacement badge. A missing name badge is considered a fine, and this MUST be taken care of before your student can receive their yearbook or earn a free dress day for field day.
