HEIRLOOM CHERRY TOMATOES Heirloom cherry tomatoes are petite round cherry tomatoes that come in an array of flavors and assortment of shapes and colors, from pale yellow and sun-gold orange to bright red, Cherokee purple and marbled green. They are Juicy, low-acidic with high sugar content. Heirloom tomatoes are believed to have been around since the late 1800's in France. Shortly before that time many believed that tomatoes were poisonous. Once found that they are not poisonous many started saying tomatoes had something about them that made you fall in love and they took on the French name 'pomme d'amour' which means 'love apple.' All tomatoes are now among the most common household gardens. Heirloom tomatoes are great sources of potassium, vitamin A, vitamin C, and some iron and calcium making them very nutrient rich. They are great in salads, soups, sauces, pastas or just eaten plain.
