March Builder Theme: I am a Builder When I am Willing to Try and When I Believe in my Ability to Succeed

This month's Builder theme is a powerful one. Learning is hard work. Doing something for the very first time can feel so BIG. I think of our kindergarteners—learning to recognize and carefully trace their ABCs during the first weeks of school. Counting and solving their very first math problems: $2 + 1 = 3!$ I think of our 4th graders—memorizing a **FOUR PAGE** poem with 130 lines! Who does that?! (Our 4th graders! That's who!) I think of our 6th grade students solving math problems of this high level of complexity: *Pedro raced 96 kilometers from Perry to Medford and then idled back. If the round trip took 8 hours, what was Pedro's average speed in kilometers per hour?*

If we showed that crazy long poem or that difficult word problem to a five-year-old scholar—could they imagine that they would be able to do those same hard things in just a few, short years. When we believe in our ability to succeed and when we are willing to try—the answer is YES!


