October Builders Theme: I am a Builder when I am perfectly honest.

Many years ago, I had a kindergartener in my office who was having a rough day and needed a break from being in the classroom. As we chatted, I told him that I was sure a five-year-old like him was big enough to do all the things his teacher was asking him to do. He responded, "I'm not five!" "Are you six?" I asked. "No—I am four!" he said emphatically. I tried to persuade him otherwise, but he stuck to his story. "I AM four!"

I wondered if we had made an enrollment error! I checked our records—I even double checked his birth certificate! The little guy was five...but insistent that he was four. They mystery was solved when he explained, "My mom always tells the people that I am four when we go to the movies!" Mom was embarrassed when called, but learned a valuable lesson that day. Our children are always watching, always listening and learning from our examples—whether we realize they are paying attention or not. Let's give them perfectly honest examples to follow! I am a Builder when I am perfectly honest.

White Ribbon Week – Return Tracking Sheet on Friday—and Wear a Favorite Hat!

We have been enjoying the activities and videos of "White Ribbon Week" and learning about making wise choices with media and technology. Additionally, please review the infraction and banned items list with your children. We have had two recent incidents where a banned item was brought in a backpack. Even if brought innocently, it can result in serious discipline consequences. The listed items are never allowed on campus.
