Parents—if you have any siblings that you hope to enroll for next year, now is the time to start that process. You will start the process by signing up for an application tour at West Valley 1. Re-enrollment meetings starting at the end of January

If your student is returning to American Prep next year, pay close attention to the upcoming dates of our "Celebration of Excellence" re-enrollment meetings. You must attend one of the six meetings listed below to begin the re-enrollment process for your student(s). *Make sure you arrive on time; late arrivals will be asked to return on a different day.* The meetings will last about 45 minutes. Keep in mind:

- Families with 6th grade students going into 7th grade will attend a WV2 meeting.
- If you have students at both campuses, please plan on attending a meeting at both schools.
- If your student is not meeting promotion requirements at this time, a 2024-2025 seat will be reserved for them, but their grade assignment will be finalized later in the spring, depending on their progress in meeting promotion requirements.

• Families who choose not to attend a re-enrollment meeting will be withdrawn for the 2024-2025 school year and will need to go through the lottery process @ www.americanprep.org to seek registration for next year...so if you are coming back, please don't miss your meeting!

Campus Transfer Applications: Link Now Available

If your student is already an American Prep student and would like to request a transfer to a different campus, the link is now available. Transfer applications must be submitted each calendar year, so even if you've applied before, you'll need to apply again for 2024-2025. 6th grade students going to 7th grade at West Valley 3 do NOT need to request a transfer. This will happen automatically when you re-enroll and if they are meeting promotion requirements for 6th grade.
