New Siblings Enrollment & Re-Enrollment Meetings

- If you have students at both campuses, please plan on attending a meeting at both schools.
- If your student is not meeting promotion requirements at this time, a 2024-2025 seat will be reserved for them, but their grade assignment will be finalized later in the spring, depending on their progress in meeting promotion requirements.

• Families who choose not to attend a re-enrollment meeting will be withdrawn for the 2024-2025 school year and will need to go through the lottery process @ www.americanprep.org to seek registration for next year...so if you are coming back, please don't miss your meeting!

Campus Transfer Applications: Link Now Available

If your student is already an American Prep student and would like to request a transfer to a different campus, the link is now available. Transfer applications must be submitted each calendar year, so even if you've applied before, you'll need to apply
