### Field Trips! K-3 Thank you Chaperones! 4th-6th Field Trips Next Week on 4/23.

*Thank you to those parents who have completed the fingerprinting requirements to be chaperones for field trips!* A list of parents able to chaperone has been shared with the teachers. Parents who complete the process will receive a clearance letter from HR. If you received a clearance letter but this is not indicated on the "approved" list we received from HR, please let us know asap so we can verify with HR.

# If you have not completed the process, we will look forward to your volunteer help in other ways. We ask that only parents signed up as chaperones attend the field trips.

This mandatory fingerprinting process is required by the state of Utah for chaperones and other volunteers working with students (this could be at school events, as chaperones on field trips, during after school clubs, or other time spent in a supervisory capacity with students.)
